Description

Goldberg is a steep location that is listed as a section of the Mugler vineyard. The slope facing south-east, with an incline of up to 67%, produces its own cool wine style. The Rossatzbach stream flows down the trench to this vineyard, bringing cool winds and causing strong temperature fluctuations.
